The Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department formed in 1947 serves the northwest portion of the town of Walworth, NY. We provide a wide array of services to our community including but not limited to: Fire protection, rescue services including emergency extrication at motor vehicle accidents, Haz Mat first response and EMS first response assisting the Walworth Ambulance. In addition to these services provided in our fire district, we also respond when called into neighboring fire districts such as Walworth, West Walworth, Ontario and Webster as needed. All services are provided on a 24 hour a day 7 days a week basis.

The Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department is a 100% volunteer organization with no paid staff of any kind. In an average year, we run approximately 100 calls. This number has steadily risen over the past 20 years.

The department's monthly business meeting is held the first Monday of the month while training occurs all other Mondays of the month. An occasional weekend or off-night training may be held if necessary. During the months of April, May, September and October a chicken barbeque is held to raise funds for the department.

Expectations for Active Members of the Lincoln Fire Department:

1. Report to alarms when available.
2. Report to scheduled drills and meetings: a required minimum of 8 drills and 6 meetings per year.
3. Conduct myself in a manner befitting my position as a member of the Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department while on duty or representing the department in any way.
4. Perform such duties as may be required of me by the line officers, respecting their orders at all times.
5. Participate in ongoing training as required by classification and/or office.
6. Abide by all By-Laws of the Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department.

Membership will be on a probationary period of twelve (12) months. Failure to meet the requirements specified in Article II, Section 7 of the Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department By-Laws may result in removal from membership at any time during the twelve month period.
